That reduces the risk of making false judgments about how successful an approach is. This evidence is backed by research, and it is much more trustworthy.

### EBIP | Evidence-Based Instructional Practices

Evidence-based Practices in Instruction Evidenced-based practices are those “effective educational strategies supported by evidence and research” (ESEA, 2002). When teachers use evidence-based practices with fidelity, they can be confident their teaching is likely to support student learning and achievement of CCRS.

Evidence-based math instruction helps students with dyscalculia because it provides them with the explicit guidance and scaffolding they need to help them gain the skills and understanding. Students may also struggle with math because of trouble with executive functioning. Math requires students to pay attention to details, plan, and self-monitor.
